Melatonin: Another Treatment Option for Adrenal Gland Disease in Ferrets!

Adrenal gland disease is one of the most common problems (age 3-7 years). seen in pet ferrets. In ferrets with adrenal gland disease, the adrenal gland(s) is overproducing the sex hormones (estrogen, progestins. and testosterone). These hormones cause the clinical problems such as alopecia (**the bald ferret see photo**), itchy skin, an enlarged vulva (females), an enlarged prostate (males), increase in body odor, increase in aggressive behavior ("steroid rage"), a return of sexual behavior (neck grabbing, mounting, and even pelvic thrusting). Medical treatment instead of surgery may be needed in older ferrets, ferrets with other illness that would make anesthesia and surgery a high risk, or in cases where the owner declines surgery. There is a new product that can be used to stop the stimulation to the adrenal glands, and thus stop the overproduction of the hormones, Ferretonin (the melatonin implant). Here are answers to questions by the veterinarians that will use the Ferretonin.

Question: What is it and how do they come?

Answer: ***Ferretonin*** is a melatonin implant (the implant size is smaller than that of a micro-chip device (piece of rice) and melatonin is 100% natural product produced naturally by your ferret. We are just naturally adding more melatonin to the ferret's system to regulate the hormones. Ferretonin comes in a Gas sterilized, Pre-loaded, Disposable, Implanting Device to ensure the safety and wellness of your ferrets. Ferretonin must be administered by a Veterinarian due to the large needle (12 gauge) and the cost is available by contacting one of our nationwide distributors.

Question: How does it help the ferret with Adrenal Disease?

Answer: ***Ferretonin*** implant will reverse the following systems over 90% of the time in all ferrets over a 2 to 4 month period. Hair Re-growth, including tail, Subsides Aggressive/Mating Behavior, Weight & Muscle Gain, eliminates itchy skin and odor problems, Assists with Urination (in males) & Reduces swollen vulvas (in females)! It is also being used every 6 months as an Adrenal Disease prevention device.

Question: Where is the implant site, what is the dose protocol and shelf life, how is it done and where can I get more information?

Answer: ***Ferretonin*** is implanted exactly as a micro chip and goes subcutaneous between the shoulder blades and is to be administered every 4 to 6 months with a product shelf life of 2 years. Used in pre & post Adrenal Disease surgery as well as preventive in ferrets 3 years or more of age. Downloadable instructions are available on the Melatek web site as to exactly how to implant.
